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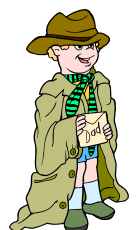

This month we will be celebrating more 1st Birthdays. Ben and Allie will soon be joining Ava in the 1 yr. old club!

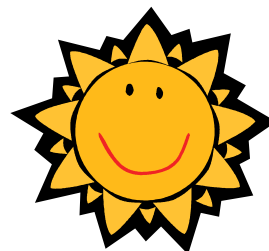
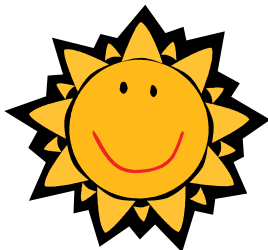
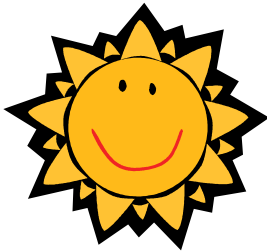

Allie- is now crawling everywhere! She loves to chase her friend Ava around.

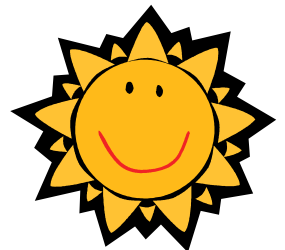
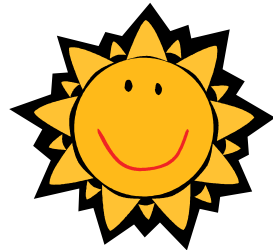
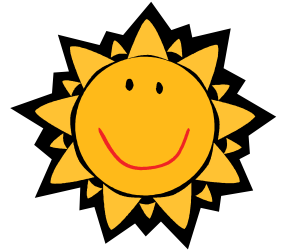
Ben- loves to roll around the room and play with his friends. He has been practicing getting up on his knees!

June will be filled with summertime fun! We will be doing fun beach activities and learning about our 5 senses.

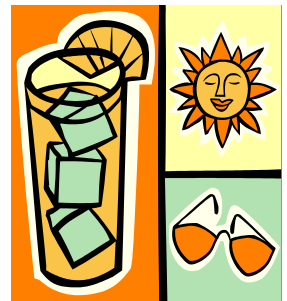
